Explanatory Note.

The purpose of this draft Law is to allow the Royal Court, on the motion of the Attorney General, to order the cancellation of the registration of a person as a dentist, if that person's name has been erased from the Dentists' Register in the United Kingdom for failure to pay the annual registration fee.

The opportunity has been taken to introduce a new interpretation provision whereby references in the Law to enactments including United Kingdom enactments are to be construed as references to those enactments as amended.

THE STATES, subject to the sanction of Her Most Excellent Majesty in Council, have adopted the following Law -

ARTICLE 1.

After paragraph (2) of Article 1 of the Dentists (Registration) (Jersey) Law, 1961,¹ as amended, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law") there shall be inserted the following paragraph -

“(3) Where this Law refers to any enactment (and in this paragraph “enactment” includes an enactment of the United Kingdom) the reference is a reference to that enactment as amended and includes a reference to that enactment as extended or applied by or under any other enactment, including any other provisions of that enactment.”.

ARTICLE 2.

In Article 8 of the principal Law² -

- (a) after the figures "1957" there shall be inserted the words ", or by Regulations made under that Act"; and
- (b) in paragraph (3) the words ", as amended" shall be deleted.

ARTICLE 3.

This Law may be cited as the Dentists (Registration) (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Law, 198.
