Report

Regulation 2 of the Health and Safety at Work Appeal Tribunal (Jersey) Regulations, 1989 establishes a tribunal, to be known as the Health and Safety Appeal Tribunal and consisting of a chairman and deputy chairman (who must both be advocates or solicitors of not less than seven years' standing) and two other members appointed by the States.

The attached proposition asks the States whether they are of opinion to appoint the persons listed thereon as members of the Health and Safety Appeal Tribunal, for a period of three years, commencing 1st November, 1989, the date on which it is envisaged that the Health and Safety at Work (Jersey) Law, 1989 and the subordinate Regulations will come into force.
