Explanatory Note

The effect of these draft Regulations is to allow part-time employees of the States who are required to join the retirement pension scheme as new members, to opt to be treated as joining (and therefore to pay back contributions) with effect from 31st August 1989 instead of 1st January 1988, as was required under Regulation 2(4) of the Public Employees (Contributory Retirement Scheme) (New Members) (Jersey) Regulations 1989.

THE STATES, in pursuance of Article 2 of the Public Employees (Retirement) (Jersey) Law 1967,¹ as amended,² have made the following Regulations -

1. For paragraph (4) of Regulation 2 of the Public Employees (Contributory Retirement Scheme) (New Members) (Jersey) Regulations 1989³ there shall be substituted the following paragraphs -

“(4) It shall be compulsory for an employee qualified in accordance with paragraph (2)(a)(iii) and (2)(a)(v) who has not opted to be a member to whom the 1989 Existing Members Regulations apply, to be a member of the scheme to whom these Regulations apply. Such an employee shall be required to pay contributions as specified in Regulation 3 as from the appointed day but may be allowed to pay by instalments, over such period as the Committee may

determine, the amount due for the period which has already elapsed.

(4A) It shall be compulsory for an employee qualified in accordance with paragraph (2)(a)(iv) who has not opted to be a member to whom the 1989 Existing Members Regulations apply, to be a member of the scheme to whom these Regulations apply, but such an employee may, at his option, enter the scheme as from the thirty-first day of August 1989 instead of from the appointed day. Such an employee shall be required to pay contributions as specified in Regulation 3 as from the date on which he joins the scheme but may be allowed to pay by instalments, over such period as the Committee may determine, the amount due from the period which has already elapsed.”.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Employees (Contributory Retirement Scheme) (New Members) (Amendment) (Jersey) Regulations 199 and shall come into force
