I visited and stayed briefly with [redacted] at the General Hospital on Saturday 31st May 1986.

I reassured her about all the children.

I did not mention to all the children's temporary absence from the [redacted]

[redacted] has left the question of alternative placement for the [redacted] youngsters to myself. I explained that we had in mind the Maguires, that I had every confidence in them and that Mr. and Mrs. Maguire or perhaps just Mrs. Maguire would like to see her [redacted] in the near future so they could familiarise.

On Sunday 1st June I took all [redacted] children from the [redacted] to 'have a look-see' at F.G.H., i.e. Squez. All parties are happy with each other and the children have expressed their keenness to transfer to F.G.H.

As there was some urgency due to the fact that [redacted] are finding coping very difficult, Mr. and Mrs. Maguire have agreed to accept the children on Saturday 17th June and I will undertake the transfer.
