## **PROPOSITION**

**to request the Bailiff to inform the Secretary of State that it is the wish of the Assembly that the Amendments\*, as proposed in a draft Exchange of Letters, of the Convention on Social Security between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Republic of Cyprus should apply to Jersey.**

**Report**

**On 13th December 1983 the States of Jersey agreed that the Convention on Social Security between the United Kingdom and the Republic of Cyprus should apply to Jersey.**

**The Convention has been in force since 1983 and purpose of the proposed Amendment is to extend the terms of the Convention to apply to H.M. Government's Sovereign Base Areas in Cyprus.**
