Nicholson Park. The Children's Officer reported that the new Houseparents were at present getting to know the children, and would move in as soon as the present occupants were able to move [redacted].

VI. JUNIOR TRAINING CENTRE. SUPERVISOR'S REPORT.

Mrs. Abbott presented her report. 46 children attend the Centre.

It was reported that the two rooms in the old building had now been inspected by Deputies Queree and Jeune, and the question of their being used by the Children was to be considered by the Education Committee.
