

In respect of the correspondence received from Eversheds LLP dated 16/07/2014, in which they request details of prosecutions in respect of named individuals, I report as follows:-

Anthony JORDAN

- a) JORDAN was charged with a total of 14 offences subject of the attached document [REDACTED]
- b) He entered Not Guilty pleas to all Counts.
- c) After Royal Court trial he was convicted on 26/11/2010 in respect of 8 Counts, namely Counts 36, 39, 40, 41, 44, 45, 46 and 47. The Crown offered no evidence in respect of Counts 37 and 38.
- d) He was sentenced on 06/01/2011 to a total of 6 months imprisonment

Morag JORDAN

- a) Morag JORDAN was charged with a total of 35 offences subject of the attached document [REDACTED]
- b) She entered Not Guilty pleas to all Counts.
- c) After Royal Court trial she was convicted on 26/11/2010 in respect of 8 Counts, namely Counts 2, 16, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24 and 27. The Crown offered no evidence in respect of Counts 18, 19, 34 and 35.
- d) She was sentenced on 06/01/20 to a total of 9 months imprisonment

Leslie Francis HUGHES

- a) HUGHES was charged with 5 offences of indecency against girls in his care as detailed within the enclosed document [REDACTED]
- b) He entered provisional Guilty pleas to all Counts when making his first appearance at the Magistrates Court on 28/03/1989.
- c) HUGHES was sentenced to a period of 3yrs imprisonment at the Royal Court on 22/06/1989.

Alan and Jane MAGUIRE

- a) In January 1998 both Alan and Jane were charged with offences of Cruelty under Article 9(1) of Children's Jersey Law 1969. 7 and 5 charges respectively.
- b) They appeared at the Magistrates Court on 05/03/1998 where Not Guilty pleas were entered by both to all charges.
- c) On 08/06/1998 a Committal hearing took place before Judge TROTT. During the proceedings Alan MAGUIRE apparently took ill and disclosed his illness. The hearing appears to have been adjourned at this point. Following this certain decisions

were made concerning the credibility of witnesses and their ability to stand up to giving evidence at the Royal Court. As a result a decision was made to abandon the prosecution. It appears a promise was made to produce medical evidence to support MAGUIRE's claim that he did not have long to live. No such item has been located among the case papers. The decision to abandon the case was made by Advocate A BINNINGTON and a copy of his letter can be found in the file.

The Attorney General subsequently decided not to re-instate the proceedings.

Following the decision to abandon the prosecution Jane MAGURIE faced an internal hearing resulting in her being dismissed from employment in Social Services. This decision was made by Anton SKINNER and a copy of his report is contained within the file.

The MAGUIRES then left Jersey and moved to France within weeks. Officers from Operation Rectangle travelled to France in order to interview MAGUIRE but he died on 14/06/2009 before the process could be completed.

- [REDACTED]
- a) [REDACTED] was not interviewed by the Police enquiry. He was not charged with any offences.

Michael AUBIN

- a) AUBIN was charged with 11 offences of Procuring Acts of Gross Indecency, Sodomy and Attempted Sodomy, and Indecent Assault. See the attached document [REDACTED]
- b) At his Royal Court trial he initially entered Not Guilty pleas to all Counts and the trial commenced. During the proceedings expert opinion was given in relation to the reliability of admissions made during his Police interviews. Consequently, on 12/05/2009, AUBIN offered Guilty pleas in respect of 2 Counts of Indecent Assault and 2 Counts of Procuring Acts of Gross Indecency. The remaining Counts were allowed to remain on the file.
- c) AUBIN was sentenced on 22/06/2009 to a period of 2yrs Probation. AUBIN had already spent 19 months on remand. See [REDACTED]
