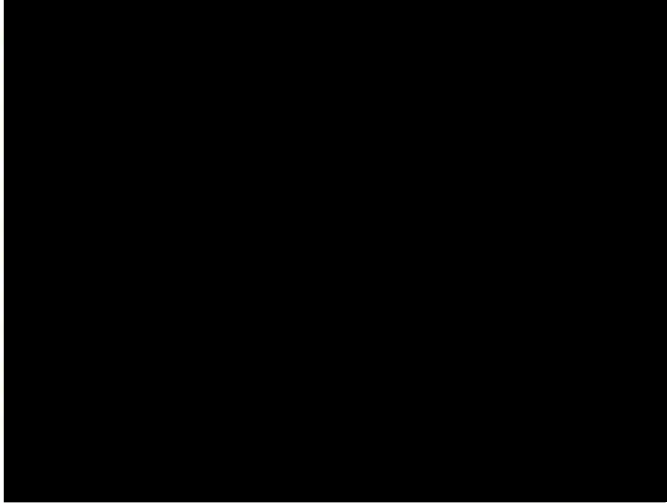
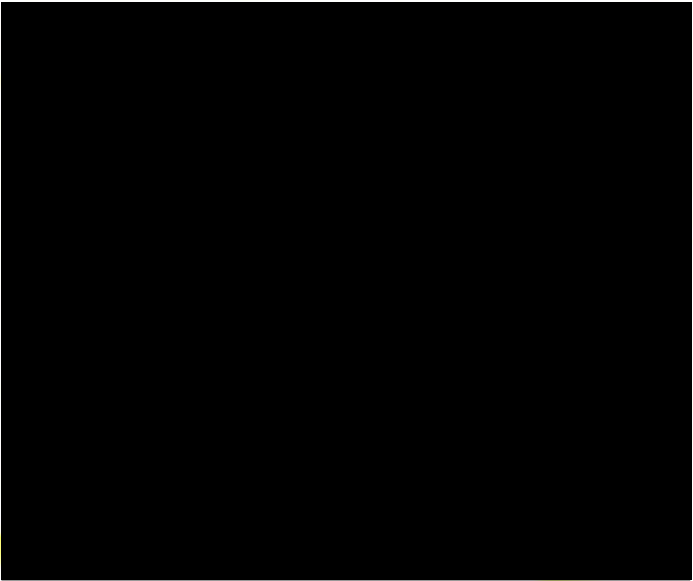


GENERAL MATTERS

[redacted] is a committed young person by virtue of a Parental Rights Order granted on [redacted] 70. and [redacted] is currently residing at Haut de la Garenne. [redacted] presently attends Hautlieu School and is to sit [redacted] G.C.E. 'O' Level examinations in the Summer. Following such examinations it is recommended by the School that [redacted] apply for admission to a One Year Full-Time Course at Highlands College; preferably the Pre-Nursing Course or otherwise the B.E.C. General Diploma Course. This would mean further Committee support for the prescribed period of time should [redacted] be accepted. (C.C.O. R.D.)

[redacted] 66. currently c/o [redacted] is committed to the Care of the Education Committee by virtue of a Parental Rights Order on 18.6.70. [redacted] until very recently, lived at Haut de la Garenne and attended Hautlieu School. She remains a student at the School but having agitated for some time to leave Haut de la Garenne did in fact do so of her own accord on 9.5.83. having formed an association with a Mr. [redacted] who pays her board and incidentals whilst she lives with [redacted] It is alleged the association is platonic only. The Crown Officers have been consulted and we are advised that we have no powers to change this situation. [redacted] shortly takes her G.C.E. 'O' Levels and is likely to succeed and it is her intention to remain at school to sit 'A' Levels. She has been seen by members of the child care staff since leaving Haut de la Garenne and offered advice and guidance whenever required. (C.C.O. R.D.)
