Mr. Thomson had a long chat last evening with _____ and feels that the girl is now very keen to make a move towards her re-integration into the _____ household.

_____ has made it plain that she expects many more privileges and freedoms if the ultimate full-time return is to prove successful.

_____ in my opinion is perhaps being manipulative and capitalizing somewhat on the current situation. I would agree that some concessions are called for but feel just as certain that discussions between all parties must take place to ensure a decent compromise is reached. Mr. Thomson states that _____ would like to spend some time at the Foster-Home this coming weekend and even perhaps stay overnight on Saturday.

I would not disagree with this but have insisted that I see _____ tomorrow evening (27.6.80) to ensure that she is absolutely sure of my expectations and a definite contract made.

Before seeing _____ I took the opportunity to speak with _____. The picture she painted of _____ behaviour seemed contrary to information supplied by Mr. Thomson.

_____ it was alleged, had been extremely difficult at mealtime that evening, taking a posture against _____. It is accepted that _____ does not like _____, but such hostilities are not recommended in the group. It seemed interesting that _____ should have chosen to agitate and irritate the evening before she was due to return to her Foster home. _____ had however been told she would be allowed to go home prior to this time by Mr. Thomson to which I had agreed that all things being equal would serve as a step in the right direction towards rehabilitation.

I was not amused to learn from _____ that _____ behaviour was consistently poor, and that the girl seemed to be definitely very capable of playing 'divide and rule' with the Staff and was becoming most

accomplished in playing the system.

_____ believes _____ to be sexually precocious and also capable of seducing the older boys.

_____ will always try to achieve her own ends and has on at least several occasions when refused by Staff to leave the grounds at Haut de la Garenne has in fact defied such instructions, leaving Haut de la Garenne and returning several hours later. On these occasions I gather from _____ that some action in the way of the restriction of privileges was taken, but that shift rotation of Staff seemed to make this punishment somewhat inconsistent.

I have never been notified of such rebellious misbehaviour officially from Haut de la Garenne. This is most annoying - as to be able to operate any sort of ongoing programme surely must be dependant on total liaison and co-operation between ourselves and Haut de la Garenne. Knowledge of the aforementioned recorded events may well have meant that I would have wished to follow a different course of therapy and also would not in all probability considered that the girl should have been allowed to have stayed overnight at her Foster home, over the week-end of 28/29th June.

I think because of the breakdown in communication and because of _____ behaviour at Haut de la Garenne, coupled with certain reservations about whether the Foster Parents can be considered totally co-operative, seems to indicate that a Case Discussion might be convened as soon as possible.

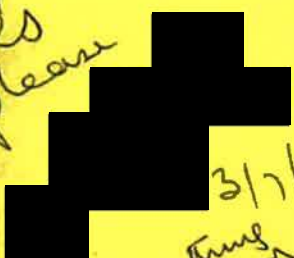
