Explanatory Note

These Regulations amend further the Policing of Parks (Jersey) Regulations 1962 ("the principal Regulations") by -

- (a) increasing the fine for most offences against the principal Regulations from £50 to £500 (level 2 on the standard scale);**
- (b) providing that, where the offence is dealt with summarily by a Constable or Centenier, in which case the fine imposed may not exceed £50 (level 1 on the standard scale), the fine will be awarded for the benefit of the parish.**

The maximum penalty for offences connected with the operation of the road train is unchanged (level 3 on the standard scale (£2000) and/or imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months).

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by the Order in Council of the twenty-sixth day of December 1851,¹ Article 49 of the Road Traffic (Jersey) Law 1956, as amended,² and the Policing of Roads, Parks and Sea Beaches (Applications of Fines) (Jersey) Law 1957, as amended,³ have made the following Regulations -

1. For Regulations 6 and 7 of the Policing of Parks (Jersey) Regulations 1962, as amended,⁴ there shall be substituted the following Regulations -

“PENALTIES FOR OFFENCES

6.-(1) If any person contravenes any provision of paragraph (3), (4) or (5) of Regulation 4B of these Regulations, he shall be liable to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months or to both such fine and such imprisonment.

(2) If any person contravenes any other provision of these Regulations or fails to comply with any condition subject to which any permission under these Regulations is granted, he

shall be liable to a fine not exceeding level 2 on the standard scale.

APPLICATION OF FINES LEVIED SUMMARILY

7. All fines for offences against these Regulations which are levied summarily by a Connétable or Centenier in exercise of powers conferred on him by Article 1 of the Policing of Roads, Parks and Sea Beaches (Application of Fines) (Jersey) Law 1957, as amended, shall be awarded for the benefit of the parish in which the offence was committed and shall be applied towards the cost of maintenance of the by-roads of that parish."

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Policing of Parks (Amendment No. 10) (Jersey) Regulations 1995 and shall come into force on the first day of May 1995.
