Collin will be contacting you tomorrow to ask for an urgent meeting tomorrow.

I am tied up between 11 and 15.30 with a Public Accounts Committee meeting but I would underline the urgency of this meeting which I would like to attend. I understand that with your busy schedule this may not be possible but I would like to underline my support for Collin and my concern that this particular matter should be nipped in the bud before it gets totally out of hand.

It is my opinion that there is the danger of a grave miscarriage of Justice and, possibly, the police exposing themselves to the accusation of using police assets to conduct a personal vendetta.

It is also my opinion, which is shared by others of my colleagues, that the particular case may well be being used as a blocking mechanism against the current crop of complaints being investigated by the Devon and Cornwall Police.

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
