The Children's Service received a referral from Elsa Fernandes of the Jersey Family Court Advisory Service on the 04.01.2011 in relation to concerns you had for your children when they are in the care of [REDACTED]

In addition to this I know from the Police that you also delivered to them a 'pen drive' which contained taped footage and audio information on it which you had acquired.

I am able to now inform you that an Enquiry has been undertaken in respect of the information received and based on the information provided from our partner agencies, the Police, Health and Education the Children's Service see no reason at this time to intervene in the private life of the family.

Such Enquiries are made by Police, Health, Education and the Children's Service whenever there are concerns raised in respect of children as is our duty; however on this occasion we have not been provided with information to identify your children as having suffered or likely to suffer harm.

If you have any questions concerning the content of this letter please do contact me to discuss further.

Should you have any further concerns regarding the care of your children please do inform the Police at the time of the incident.
