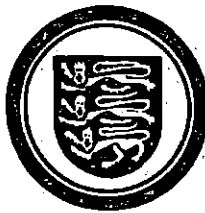

Explanatory Note.

The purpose of this Bill is to make minor amendments to the Old Person's Homes (Registration) (Jersey) Law, 1964 to enable registration fees to be amended by Order instead of Regulations and to remove the restrictions on the maximum amounts of fines.

THE STATES, subject to the sanction of Her Most
Excellent Majesty in Council, have adopted the following
Law:-

ARTICLE 1.

In Article 1 of the Old Person's Homes (Registration)
(Jersey) Law, 1964,¹ as amended (hereinafter referred to as
"the principal Law") for sub-paragraph (c) of the definition of
"old person's home" there shall be substituted the following
sub-paragraph -

"(c) a mental nursing home within the meaning of the
Mental Health (Jersey) Law, 1969, as amended;"

ARTICLE 2.

In paragraph (1) of Article 2 of the principal Law² -

- (a) the words "not exceeding fifty pounds", the words "not exceeding one hundred pounds" and the words "not exceeding ten pounds a day" shall be deleted;
- (b) for the words "both such fine and such imprisonment" there shall be substituted the words "both a fine and such imprisonment".

ARTICLE 3.

Article 2A of the principal Law³ shall be repealed.

ARTICLE 4.

In Article 5 of the principal Law⁴ after paragraph (2) there shall be inserted the following paragraph -

"(2A) The Committee may by order prescribe the fee payable under paragraph (3) of Article 2 of this Law".

ARTICLE 5.

In Article 8 of the principal Law⁵ the words "not exceeding ten pounds" and the words "not exceeding five pounds" shall be deleted.

ARTICLE 6.

(1) This Law may be cited as the Old Person's Homes (Registration) (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Law, 198 .
