Explanatory Note.

These Regulations amend the principal Regulations by increasing with effect from the 1st January, 1983 the fees payable for the entry, retention and restoration of a person's name on the roll of ancillary dental workers from £5 for a first enrolment, £2 for retention on the roll and £2 for restoration to the roll to £6 for a first enrolment, £3 for retention on the roll and £3 for restoration to the roll.

THE STATES, in pursuance of Article 10 of the Dentists (Registration) (Jersey) Law, 1961¹ have made the following Regulations:-

1. In Regulation 12 of the Ancillary Dental Workers (Jersey) Regulations, 1974,² as amended³ -

(a) for the words "£5" there shall be substituted the words "£6"; and

(b) for the words "£2" in both places where they occur there shall be substituted the words "£3".

2. The Ancillary Dental Workers (Amendment) (Jersey) Regulations, 1981³ are hereby repealed.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Ancillary Dental Workers (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Regulations, 1982 and shall come into force on the first day of January, 1983.
