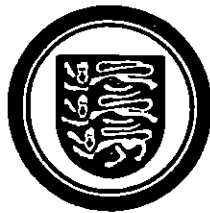

Explanatory Note

These draft Regulations amend a part of the Beer Duty (Drawback) (Jersey) Regulations, 1946. The purpose of these Regulations is to alter from 36 gallons to 1 hectolitre the minimum quantity of each consignment of beer on which drawback will be allowed.

This is consistent with Part V of the Finance (Jersey) Law, 1981 by which the charging provisions for beer duty are expressed in metric quantities instead of imperial quantities.

THE STATES, by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Article 4 of the "Loi (1937) sur la perception d'un impôt sur la bière", as amended,¹ have made the following Regulations:-

1. In sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph (2) of Regulation 3 of the Beer Duty (Drawback) (Jersey) Regulations, 1946, as amended,² for the words "thirty-six gallons" there shall be substituted the words "one hectolitre".

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Beer Duty (Drawback) (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Regulations, 1981 and shall be deemed to have come into force on the first day of January 1981.
