Explanatory Note

The purpose of this Law is to increase from £10 to £100 the penalty for failing to make a declaration or for giving a false declaration at a census and to remove the limit of £100 on the fine which can be imposed for improper disclosure of census information.

THE STATES, subject to the sanction of Her Most
Excellent Majesty in Council, have adopted the following
Law:—

ARTICLE 1.

In Article 4 of the Census (Jersey) Law, 1951⁽¹⁾— 5

- (a) in paragraph (1), for the words “ten pounds sterling”
there shall be substituted the words “one hundred
pounds”;
- (b) in paragraph (2), the words “not exceeding one
hundred pounds sterling” are hereby repealed. 10

ARTICLE 2.

This Law may be cited as the Census (Amendment) (Jersey)
Law, 197 .
